

Dear All Saints Catholic Community,

The Board of Trustees wishes you a blessed Advent season. We hope that you and your family enjoy the Christmas break. Before we head into the new year and as a continuation of the board's commitment to communicating more directly with our community, we would like to share a few brief updates with you related to the most recent board meeting on December 18th.

Open and Future board seats

- The board received seven applications to fill the open seat for the remainder of the school year. The board is grateful for all who expressed an interest in serving. Those applications were reviewed and discussed at our meeting. The board's next step is to select a potential candidate. This candidate will be submitted to Bishop Gruss for approval. If/when approved, we will follow up with all parties that submitted an application. We hope to have this process completed before the board meeting scheduled for January 21, 2026.
- All Saints Catholic (ASC) will be working with the Diocese on the process on individually incorporating ASC as a separate non-profit entity. This process is similar to what has recently taken place with parishes throughout the diocese. As we learn about the board structure under incorporation and factor in rotation of members, we will share updates with our community. The diocese has not established a specific timeline for the process.

Committees

- The board is appreciative of community members that expressed interest in serving on committees. The interest forms were reviewed and discussed at the board meeting. Board members will be following up with each applicant after the new year. The board will continue to accept applications from those interested in serving. Recent school-wide survey

- Thank you to all those who took the time to complete the recent survey. As was shared in the Cougar Chronicle, the response rate was strong given "industry standards" related to submission rates. The qualitative and quantitative data was reviewed and discussed at the board meeting. Overall, the data was positive, with at least 82% of responses being favorable in all categories. The board and school leadership also reviewed the comments in an effort to identify trends and/or themes. As we continue to gather feedback, we will be surveying staff, students as well as conducting follow up surveys with families during the remainder of the school year.

State of the School

- With the support of the administrative team, the board is striving to provide a state of the school update to our community in late January or early February. Specific information related to this opportunity will be shared in the new year.
