## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear All Saints Catholic Families,

As we move into the new year, we remain committed to our Journey to Excellence for All Saints Catholic Schools. In the previous Cougar Chronicle, I noted that more details and action items would be coming via this newsletter regarding the details of the Journey to Excellence plan. In this edition, we will highlight the building of the 2026-2031 Strategic Plan and the enhancement of our Catholic Identity and Mission.

**2026-2031 Strategic Plan:** In July of 2025, the Leadership Team began examining the key components of an excellent Catholic school as outlined by the National Catholic Education Association. On a monthly basis, the Leadership Team studies the rubrics for each benchmark, ranks our current practices in the benchmarks, and brainstorms areas of improvements. We have completed this process for 40 of 77 benchmarks and will be done in March. Next, teachers will be engaged in the planning process and families will be invited to the planning process toward the end of this school year. Dates for parent involvement in the planning process will be announced in the March newsletter and be held in April.

**Mission & Catholic Identity:** In October of 2025, the staff attended a full-day professional development on the integration of the Catholic faith into all school subjects. Additionally, teachers are documenting how they are integrating the faith for this school year to determine when and where we can continue to grow our students' opportunities to build our students as disciples in Christ. Examples of growing in our faith include retreats for grades 6 and 7 in February, weekly adoration and monthly confession.

I thank you for the opportunity to serve you and your family.

## Thank You Pajot Family

Our ASC Middle-High School Library is indeed fortunate and grateful to be generously endowed by the estate of Theresa & Lloyd Pajot. Some of their children attended ASC in the early years.

The library is funded with an endowment that was established from royalties of mineral rights. The fund was established in November of 2005 with the first of regular monthly payments stated in December of 2005 and have continued ever since.

The original endowment was for the ASC High School Library. When Holy Family Middle School merged into All Saints Catholic Middle & High School, the Pajot family asked that the money be shared.

The endowment has almost totally funded the library over the years. Almost \$50,000 has already benefitted the students and staff of ASC Middle & High School with an up-to-date and enhanced library. It is now totally staffed by four avid volunteers.

A Memorial Mass for Theresa & Loyd Pajot will be celebrated at the beginning of Catholic Schools Week in thanks for their generosity and that of their family to Catholic education. Mass will be held Sunday, January 25, 2026 at 10:30am at St. Boniface Church, 510 N. Lincoln Avenue, east side Bay City.
