Dear All Saints Catholic School Parents,

First, thank you for your continued support and prayers as we move forward in our time of transition and hope for the future of All Saints. As was noted in last month's Message from the President, our daily work of educating our children and growing in relationship with Christ continues as our highest commitment.

We are excited to continue the implementation of the Continuous Enrollment process to simplify the re-enrollment procedures. As was noted in the previous communication, Continuous Enrollment is designed to streamline the traditional re-enrollment process by automatically renewing your child's enrollment each year until graduation.

How Does It Work?

- You need to log into your Skyward Family Access account and verify each of your students' information.
- If you complete all the verification information beginning April 20 through May 3, you will receive a \$75 incentive off your total tuition.
- As of May 4, the incentive will no longer be available.
- There is no registration deposit required.

Should you have any trouble or questions, please call (989) 892-2533 during school hours and we will be happy to offer support. Additionally, we have two kiosks available in the middle/high school for you to use should you need internet access. Please remember to bring your most recent IRS Form 1040 showing Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) on line 11.

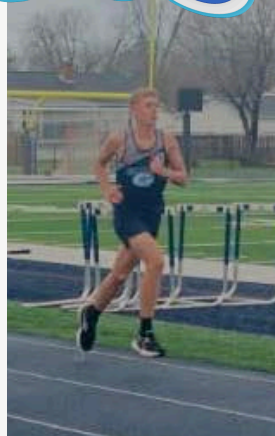


Congratulations, Kellen Proctor!

Faith Reflections

As we enter into the heart of the Lenten season (The Easter Season of the Liturgical Calendar is April 5th through May 24th, 2026.), the Theology Department at All Saints Catholic Schools invites our families to reflect more deeply on Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. This sacred time offers us a meaningful opportunity to grow in faith together and to more fully live out the beauty of our Catholic traditions.

Living with Faith in the Resurrected Christ

Life brings challenges, uncertainties, and moments of suffering, but as Christians, we do not face them alone. We are invited to reflect: Do I enter into the trials of life with faith in the Resurrected Christ? The Resurrection is the foundation of our hope. It reminds us that even in our darkest moments, God is at work bringing new life. As a family, consider how you can encourage one another to trust in Christ's victory over sin and death. Sharing personal experiences, praying together during difficult times, and keeping Christ at the center of your home can strengthen this faith.

Growing in Devotion to Divine Mercy

This season also calls us to reflect on the incredible gift of God's mercy. We ask: Can we grow in devotion to Jesus' Divine Mercy by participating in the Divine Mercy Novena? In the 1930s, Jesus appeared to Saint Faustina Kowalska, sharing a message of mercy for the world and entrusting her with the Divine Mercy Chaplet. This devotion was later promoted throughout the Church by Pope John Paul II, who established Divine Mercy Sunday as a universal feast.

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and continues for nine days, leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday—the Sunday after Easter.

What is the Easter Season?

The Easter season is fifty days from the Sunday of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ to Pentecost Sunday. The first eight days of the Easter season make up the Octave of Easter and are

celebrated as solemnities of the Lord. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. In a sense, every day of the Octave is like a little Sunday.

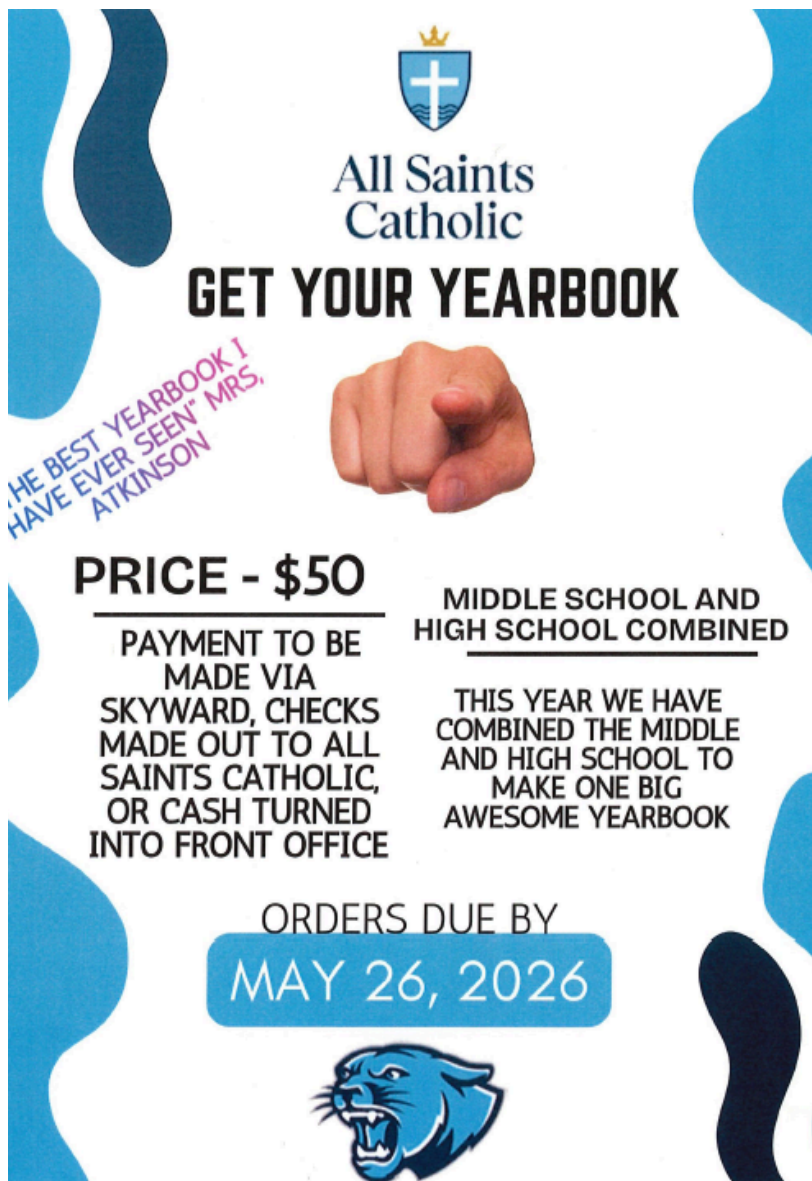
