Preschool & Elementary SUMMER CAMP - Code of Conduct

While every camper at All Saints Summer Camp deserves a rewarding and fulfilling experience, it is essential that all participants contribute to a safe, respectful, and positive environment. To ensure this, the Camp Director and staff expect each camper to follow established rules, regulations, and behavioral expectations.

The guidelines below outline the standards of behavior expected of all campers while attending All Saints Summer Camp, as well as the disciplinary procedures that may be implemented if these expectations are not met.

1. Respect for Others

Campers are expected to treat all fellow campers, staff, and members of the All Saints Summer Camp community with kindness, respect, and acceptance at all times. Negative behavior directed toward any individual will not be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to, put-downs, teasing, exclusion, inappropriate joking, aggravating behavior, or any form of bullying.

2. Respect for Diversity

Ethnically or racially charged jokes, teasing, slurs, or put-downs are strictly prohibited. Campers are expected to respect, welcome, and celebrate diversity within the All Saints Summer Camp community, and to learn from and appreciate the differences that make each individual unique.

3. Respect for Facilities and Materials

Campers are expected to respect camp facilities, equipment, and materials at all times. This includes following all clean-up procedures and expectations after each activity as directed by the Camp Director and staff.

4. Safe and Appropriate Physical Contact

Campers are expected to keep their hands and bodies to themselves at all times. Harmful or inappropriate physical contact of any kind is not permitted.

5. Fighting and Aggressive Behavior

Fighting, whether verbal or physical, will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Any form of aggressive behavior may result in immediate disciplinary action. Termination of enrollment may be considered on a case-by-case basis, depending on the severity and frequency of the behavior.

6. Appropriate Language

All Saints Summer Camp prohibits the use of foul or inappropriate language of any kind. Campers are expected to use respectful, positive, and appropriate language at all times, helping to maintain a fun and encouraging environment for everyone.

7. Following Staff Directions

Campers are expected to follow all directions given by the Camp Director and staff promptly and respectfully. Failure to comply with staff directives may result in disciplinary action.

8. Dress Code

Campers are expected to wear appropriate clothing each day. While All Saints Summer Camp does not require school uniforms, all attire must be school-appropriate. For safety reasons, campers must wear socks at all times, including with sandals, to help reduce the risk of accidents and injuries. Shoes must have a secure back (no backless footwear). Clothing should provide appropriate coverage. Items such as

spaghetti straps, short shorts, crop tops, or other revealing attire are not permitted. If a camper chooses to wear a skirt or dress, shorts must be worn underneath.

9. Participation and Safety Awareness

Campers are expected to remain attentive to all activity instructions and follow all safety rules at all times. Listening carefully and participating appropriately helps ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

10. Supervision and Group Safety

Campers must remain with their assigned group at all times. Campers are not permitted to leave the group or designated area without prior permission from the Camp Director or staff.

11. Field Trips (Walking and In-House)

All Saints Summer Camp may offer both walking field trips and in-house field trip experiences.

Campers are expected to follow all camp rules and expectations while participating in these activities.

During any field trip, campers must remain with their assigned group at all times, follow all directions from the Camp Director and staff immediately, and demonstrate respectful behavior toward peers, staff, presenters, and the surrounding environment. For walking field trips, campers must stay with the group, follow all safety procedures, and adhere to staff instructions regarding movement, spacing, and crossing areas. Safety expectations must be followed at all times. Failure to follow expectations during field trips may result in removal from the activity and further disciplinary action.

Behavior Expectations and Discipline Policy

At All Saints Catholic Schools, we are committed to providing each camper with a safe, enjoyable, and rewarding camp experience. We understand that campers may occasionally have “off” days; however, consistent positive behavior is expected from all participants to ensure the safety, well-being, and enjoyment of everyone. To maintain a safe and positive environment, the following steps may be taken when addressing inappropriate behavior. Depending on the severity of the behavior, steps may be adjusted or skipped at the discretion of the Camp Director.

The following guidelines outline how camp staff will address and respond to inappropriate or negative behaviors demonstrated by campers.

1. Warning: The camper will receive a verbal warning identifying the inappropriate behavior and will be redirected to a more appropriate activity.

2. Activity Restriction: If the behavior continues, the camper will be removed from the activity and asked to participate in an alternative activity.

3. Referral to Director: If the behavior persists or escalates, the staff member may refer the camper to the Camp Director (or staff in charge) for further discussion and intervention.

4. Dismissal: If the behavior is severe, unsafe, or continues despite prior interventions, the Camp Director or lead staff member may require immediate pick-up by a parent or guardian. If a parent/guardian cannot be reached, an emergency contact will be notified.

Continued or escalated behavior may result in the camper being asked not to return the following day or removal from the camp program without refund.
