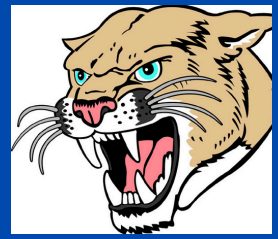

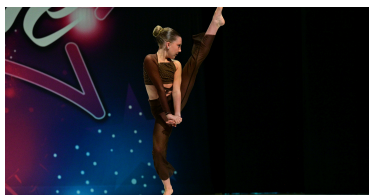

### Important News

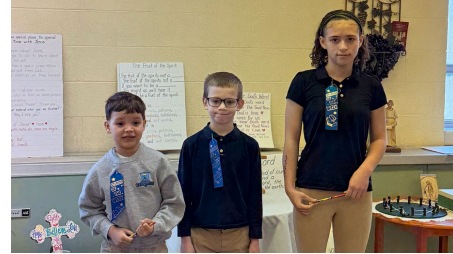
