

## **POST PROM REMINDERS**

1. **All ASC 10th, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students** are welcome to attend post-prom **if they attended Prom.**

2. **If an ASC 11th or 12th grade student does not attend Prom,** he or she is welcome to attend **Post Prom. (10th grade students who do NOT attend Prom cannot attend Post Prom.)**

3. **Non-ASC guests** are welcome at post-prom **ONLY IF** they attended Prom as the guest of a current All Saints 10th, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student. **Ninth grade students cannot** attend Prom or Post Prom.

4. All non-ASC guests must register and fill out a guest application form. Application forms should be submitted to the school office prior to the date of the event. Guests must also purchase their post prom tickets in advance. Non-ASC guests are required to adhere to the same behavior codes as ASC students.

5. Students must arrive by 11:45. Parents will be notified if students have signed up to attend post-prom and do not arrive within the 1/2 hour time frame. Students who arrive after the 1/2 hour time limit will be admitted only at the discretion of the chaperones.

**REMINDER – The pool will be open until 1:00am at Post-Prom. Please bring a bathing suit and towel if you wish to swim.**

6. Students are to remain for the entire time (11-45pm-3am.) Students may not leave and re enter at the YMCA. If a student leaves more than 15 minutes before post prom's scheduled conclusion, he/she must sign out with chaperones, and parents will be notified of departure time. If a student needs to get anything out of their car after they have checked in at post prom, they will be accompanied to their vehicle by an adult chaperone.

7. Any student's coat, purse and/or bag may be subject to a visual inspection by a chaperone. If a student does not wish to comply with a visual inspection as requested, the chaperone may choose one of the following options:

- a. Ask the student to take any item in question and leave it at the check-in table.
- b. Notify the parents and request that the student leave.

If there is suspicion of alcohol or drugs, the chaperone reserves the right to search the student and/or confiscate material. Duffel bags, backpacks, outside food or beverages are not permitted.

8. Any student or guest who is in possession or thought to be in possession of alcohol or other drugs will not attend post prom.. Parents and proper legal authorities will be notified immediately.

9. No person in junior high or more than 2 years out of high school and/or older than 20 is allowed.

10. Students are expected to conduct themselves respectfully and appropriately.

11. In order to attend an ASC function, students must dress appropriately and uphold the values of this institution. If a student is deemed to be dressed inappropriately, i.e. clothes are too revealing, they will be asked to either change clothes or leave.

12. If a student fails to comply with the above policies and procedures, additional disciplinary action, as directed by school code will follow. The privileges to attend future events may also be revoked. Students and parents should refer to the ASC Handbook.
